

Self Installation

Introduction

Installing a kitchen is much more difficult than it seems. Putting boxes in a room, leveling them and screwing them to the wall is the easy part. Getting it all to line up is where the skill comes in.

If you have done it before, then you know what you are in for. If you have never attempted an install before, DON'T. If this is something you are going to do on a regular basis, then get someone qualified to help you with your first one, then you know what is involved.

Tools

Don't try it unless you have the following tools;

- 2 x battery drills
- 1 x power drill with hammer action
- Pozi drive and square drive bits
- Set of drill bits
- A good set of screwdrivers
- Level
- Straight edge (preferably at least 2m long)
- Jigsaw
- Electric planer
- Router (optional)
- Assortment of fixing screws
- L brackets

Voids

Not all cabinets fit against the wall. Base cabinets and overheads do, but tall cabinets will have voids, so check the plan carefully.

Scribing

Most panels will need to be scribed using the planer. If you have never done this, you could use a router. If you have no idea what this means – get a professional!

Benchtops

Joining tops is an art form. Its easy to damage a top and chip the laminate – this is a costly exercise. It will need to be scribed just like the panels.

All cabinets have voids. You must ensure you adhere to these as detailed in the information pack. Moda NZ Ltd takes no responsibility if the installer fails to use the correct voids. Panels and benchtops generally need to be scribed to fit site conditions. Therefore length is added to benchtops to allow for this.

In the event of a failure of any part, Moda NZ Ltd will honour the guarantee on that item and will replace it free of charge, any labour costs incurred in replacing the part is at the customers expense.

If you encounter any problems during the installation, you should contact Vision Excel on 021 644 784. If the problem is due to a Moda fault, then Moda will cover Vision Excels costs, however if it is due to an installation problem then Vision Excel will invoice you direct.
